Just a few of his accomplishments include working with Peter Jackson on Meet The Feebles, Braindead and The Two Towers, the second film in The Lord of the Rings trilogy. He also co-wrote, with Anthony McCarten, the very popular Ladies Night which continues to be played and enjoyed around the world. This prodigious writer saw the first professional production of Remain in Light in 2017 at The Pumphouse Theatre in Auckland.

Remain in Light is gripping, lyrical and strikingly bold. Together with a large cast it uses sound and lighting technology to create a truly unique experience.
